

**YOUNG RESEARCHERS' WORKSHOP**  
**Copenhagen's 2010 ACEI Conference on Cultural Economics (June 10-12)**

**Call for participants**

A workshop for graduate students will take place on the morning of June 9, 2010 (from 9:30 am to 12:30), prior to the beginning of ACEI biennial conference in the same venue. The workshop consists of an interactive experience in which graduate students (masters and PhD) discuss dissertation, publication and job market issues amongst themselves and with scholars in the field (i.e. research on the economic aspects of culture). In the afternoon (13:30-15:00) Juan Prieto Fernández (University of Oviedo, Spain) will hold a workshop for participants (open to ACEI participants) on '*The Econometrics of Cultural Economics*'.

Xavier Greffe (University of Paris 1, France) will lead the workshop together with Tyler Cowen (George Mason University, United States). Roberto Zanola (Eastern Piedmont University, Italy), the President-Elect of the ACEI, and other members of the ACEI's Executive Board will be present.

Interested graduate students should send a CV and a 1-page abstract of his/her dissertation project, indicating the stage of his/her studies (pre or post-proposal defense), institutional affiliation and title of his/her graduate program, as well which type of job he/she envisions after graduation (academic, government, consulting,..., and if academic in which discipline), to Xavier Greffe at [xgreffe@univ-paris1.fr](mailto:xgreffe@univ-paris1.fr), Tyler Cowen at [tcowen@gmu.edu](mailto:tcowen@gmu.edu) and Roberto Zanola at [roberto.zanola@unipmn.it](mailto:roberto.zanola@unipmn.it) by April 30th, 2010.

Applicants will be informed of the decision on May 10. Applicants who need financial assistance should write a short letter with their applications, explaining why they need assistance. In the cases deemed worth funding, the ACEI will provide *up to* 500 Euros for a limited number of participants.
